

MEGAPAYMENT MODULE

The fractionated payment allows customers booking the product, up paying only a percentage of the total price, or make payment in several installments. This module is the solution for visitors who want to book a product and they do not want to pay the full amount until they receive it, or for those customers who prefer to pay in easy installments.

Before you start ...

Before starting to work with this module, we have to keep in mind that the module itself does not allow working If we have no installed various payment methods. For this module will access the tab, then we will accommodate **Megapayment** and we click on the **Configure** option.




We have possibility to contract as complementary modules, payment by bank transfer, Redsys, payment store and paypal.

This is necessary because although our customers are going to pay a percentage of the total price, we have to process the entire order.

With the module, it will simply send a portion of the price in an initial order and then we can send the remaining payments. to the customer.


From the administration, in the **Modules** tab, you can choose different payment modules with which we will work, provided that we have installed.

To do this, once selected the payment type, we must complete two fields. The first is the description field, where we can add a description in html and it will appear in the other payments that's set. No payment of booking, in the following.




We also have the ability to generate an html to mail, to tell the client that has a pending payment

With variable {totalprice} we will indicate how much the customer has to pay.



Here we will choose the product status after the first payment is made.




Configuring of partial payments. for the total order

Now we will proceed to configure partial payments for the total order. To do so will access the Options tab of megapayment module and this window will appear:

Here we can choose various options.



If we want to allow partial payments throughout the order or not. if we want them to be set from the configuration. or chosen by the customer in the cart.



Fixed partial payments from the configuration

In this case we will select to set the partial payment from the configuration.


Now, we have to indicate the amount of the first payment. Can be a fixed payment or a percentage of the price. If you choose both options will be preferred. the fixed price.

In this case we will specify a fixed price of 20 euros.

We can also specify a minimum value of the cart so that you can make a partial payment.

In this case we indicate that the minimum value of the cart are 50 euros.

Thus, when we go to our store, the partial payment option will only appear when the amount of the cart exceeds the 50 euros that we have set in the configuration.




Here we will have to choose whether we want that transport is paid on the first payment or the rest and where we want to show the payment.

We also configure the automatic sending of mail that we created earlier,. Can be for

all or payment type we want. And we will choose the order status after the first payment, although in this case is not important. We choose this option in each of the




payment methods ys this data will only run if it does not find. in the above configuration.




Then we will select if you want to automatically generate partial payments and permitted methods for these payments and we save the information.


This is the result in our store.



When we access a product, the option of booking appears to us. As we have chosen this option is only for carts over 50 euros, now it does not appear.




If we put two in quantity, the value of the car is 80 euros, and now we do have the option of booking.



As we have indicated in the configuration, the price to pay for the booking is 20 euros, fixed payment.

If we indicate a percentage, for example 50%, then the partial payment will be half the total price. In this case 40 euros.




Partial payments indicated by the customer in the cart

In this case, when the client accesses your cart, he can choose the amount that he wants to pay for the reservation, instead of a percentage or fixed price that the store has marked.

Configure partial payments for a given product


To set partial payments for a single product, we must first select NO option to allow partial payments for the total order. To do this we will access the Options tab.



Once this is done, we will access the specific product in Prestahsop and select the tab "PARTIAL PAYMENTS"

Here, we choose if we want the amount of the reserve is a fixed price or a percentage. And if partial payments are allowed or not, or if the client can reserve and pay the full amount.

We must keep in mind that the other options are the same as we configured from the module.




Fixed price

If we choose the booking price is a fixed price, that is the amount that is displayed in the store.


We will select that only allow booking and payment is 20 euros. This option is ideal for products that are not yet for sale.

As you can see, this option removes the button to send the cart and only the booking.




Percentage

We can also adjust a percentage, eg 15%. So the customer will pay only that percentage of the total payment of the product.




Functioning

Once we have configured it to our needs, we'll see how it works. First we will place an order. Once this fact our blackoffice go to the order tab.




We must keep in mind that bank transfer payments are not made at the time, so when we we access to backoffice. they appear as $0 \in$.




Later we will add payment already done by our client manually. we will choose the payment date, the method and the amount and add it.



Once done the following warning will appear, indicating the amount that the customer has already paid and he still has to pay.



Once this is done, we will create the following payments to complete the amount of the price. In this case we will create a second payment of 34 euros which will be sent to the customer on 29 May. The customer can pay by bank transfer and paypal.




From here you can validate the payment or send the mail directly.



The customer can get the information. the money paid. and remaining in a very simple way. You just have to access the Partial payments tab in your user account's online store.

MY ACCOUNT



Here, you can see the payments you have already made and those that are pending. You can also check the payment methods you can use, as we have set.



When the client access, you can read the message we indicated when we set payment types.

You can make as many partial payments as you want and the amount you want, simply by adding them from option.

Of course, you remember. add payments once made will be reflected to the amount that the customer must pay.

Final score:
